Appointment to the TANF Planning Council

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that Vicente Quintana be appointed to the position of Parent/Guardian of At-Risk Youth on the TANF Planning Council. This appointment would be effective immediately. This individual would serve for a full three-year term, which would expire on March 31, 2006.

BACKGROUND:

The TANF Planning Council advises the Chief Probation Officer in the development of the proposed expenditure plan for funds provided by the Welfare & Institutions Code, which focus on prevention and early intervention for first time offenders or youth that are at risk of being adjudicated wards of the court.

Vicente Quintana is a resident of San Mateo and currently works for the City of Burlingame. He is the father of two daughters. His background includes work in juvenile advocacy and delinquency prevention. We recommend Mr. Quintana for appointment.
