SUBJECT:Resolutions (1) Determining the Sufficiency of Resolutions to Form and<br/>Join the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency, and (2)<br/>Appointing Pete Nelson, an Officer of the California Water Service<br/>Company, as a Member of the Board of Directors of the Agency

#### **Recommendation**

(1) Adopt a resolution which determines that the resolutions to form and join the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency are sufficient to meet the requirements for formation of the Agency, and (2) adopt a resolution appointing Pete Nelson, an officer of the California Water Service Company, as a member of the Board of Directors of the Agency.

## **Background**

The Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency Act, enacted in 2002 (AB 2058), provides for the formation of an agency to participate in the coordinated planning and implementation of strategies for water supply, water conservation, water recycling and repair and improvement of the San Francisco regional water system. The Act provides that the Agency may be formed upon adoption of resolutions by at least fifteen of those public entities that purchase water from San Francisco under the Master Water Sales Contract, which represent at least 60% of the total water deliveries of all of the public entities which purchase water from San Francisco. Water Code Section 81325 provides that the Board of Supervisors shall determine, by an order entered into its minutes, whether a sufficient number of resolutions have been adopted to meet the threshold for formation of the Agency, and that the Clerk of the Board shall file a certificate with the Secretary of State identifying the name of the agency and the names of each public entity that is a member of the agency, along with a map of the boundaries of the agency.

## **Discussion**

Resolutions have been received from all 26 of the affected agencies, representing 100% of the total water deliveries under the Master Water Sales Contract. The first resolution presented for the Board's action would make the determination that the statutory thresholds for formation of the Agency have been met, and would direct the Clerk of the Board to file the required certificate with the Secretary of State.

Section 81336 of the Act provides that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County shall appoint one member to the board of directors of the newly formed Agency who is an employee or officer of the California Water Service Company. We are recommending that the Board appoint Pete Nelson, the Chief Executive Officer of the California Water Service Company, to the Board of Directors. The second resolution presented for the Board's action would appoint Pete Nelson as a member of the Board of Directors of the Agency.

#### Vision Alignment

The resolution keeps the commitment of responsible, effective and collaborative government, and goal number 22, "County and local governments effectively communicate, collaborate and develop strategic approaches to issues effecting the entire County."

#### **Fiscal Impact**

This action will result in no fiscal impact to the County.
