WALT RAMSEUR

WHEREAS, on this nineteenth day of July, two thousand and three, WALT RAMSEUR is honored for his "2nd Fortieth" birthday; and

WHEREAS, WALT RAMSEUR was born on July 19, 1923 in the small town of Morganton, North Carolina where he grew up on a small farm; and

WHEREAS, WALT RAMSEUR started college at North Carolina State University in 1940 and majored in Agriculture before being transitioned from the ROTC to the regular Army at the outbreak of World War II; and

WHEREAS, WALT RAMSEUR spent the next two and a half years in the Army training at various locales throughout the country before being transferred into the Army Air Corps where he served as a navigator on a B-24; and

WHEREAS, WALT RAMSEUR returned from the war, completed his college education in 1947 with a major in Dairy Manufacturing and entered into his short business career in Virginia before re-enlisting in the newly formed Air Force when the Korean War began where he became a pilot and earned his Captain's bars and wings; and

WHEREAS, WALT RAMSEUR finished his tour with the Air Force in 1952 and began a 38-year career as a pilot with United Airlines where he carried more than a million passengers during his tenure; and

WHEREAS, WALT RAMSEUR has been an active member and volunteered countless hours for numerous organizations including the Cub Scouts, the Boy Scouts, the Sheriff's Air Squadron, Spirit Care Convalescent Ministry, Burlingame Rotary and the Millbrae Community Airport Noise Committee; and


WHEREAS, WALT RAMSEUR has served his country and his community with distinction, honor, loyalty and compassion,


