WHEREAS, OPERATION ACCESS plays an important role in providing services to the working poor, part-time workers, low-income immigrants, and the unemployed; and


WHEREAS, OPERATION ACCESS has served over 1,100 uninsured patients and saved the public health system approximately \$4,500,000; and

WHEREAS, OPERATION ACCESS has played a vital role in numerous communities by providing important services that would not have otherwise existed; and






