FRANK HEDLEY

WHEREAS, on this twelfth day of September, two thousand and three, FRANK HEDLEY is honored for his more than thirty years of distinguished service to the City of San Bruno; and

WHEREAS, FRANK HEDLEY began his career with the City of San Bruno in August of 1973 when he was hired as a Captain for the San Bruno Police Department and appointed Chief of Police in March of 1978; and

WHEREAS, FRANK HEDLEY served as Chief of Police until December of 1994 and also served as Interim City Manager from December of 1991 until December of 1994 when he retired as Chief of Police and concluded his distinguished law enforcement career as President of the renowned California Peace Officers Association; and

WHEREAS, FRANK HEDLEY was appointed City Manager in December of 1994 and served until his official retirement date of September 14, 2003; and

WHEREAS, FRANK HEDLEY, in his capacity as City Manager, has greatly contributed to the success of the City of San Bruno by coordinating and implementing the City of San Bruno Redevelopment Agency, playing an integral part in bringing BART to San Bruno, conceiving the idea of locating a new police station near the BART station, facilitating the master planning for reuse of the former Navy site, and guiding the functional remodel and renovation of the 50 year old City Hall; and

WHEREAS, FRANK HEDLEY has also accomplished many great things as an active member of many organizations including the San Bruno Rotary Club, the 100 Club of San Mateo County and the San Mateo County Criminal Justice Council; and

WHEREAS, FRANK HEDLEY served the City of San Bruno well with his hard work ethic and tireless commitment toward improving upon the quality of life by working closely with residents and staff to see that the constituency's needs were met,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County expresses congratulations and sincere gratitude to FRANK HEDLEY for more than thirty years of outstanding service to the City of San Bruno, and wishes much happiness and good health upon his retirement and best wishes for continued success.
