COMMENDING AND HONORING

**CAPTAIN MICHAEL SCOTT**

UPON THE OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that MICHAEL SCOTT has retired from the Daly City Police Department on October 10, 2003, following thirty-two years of dedicated public service; and

WHEREAS, MICHAEL SCOTT was appointed by the City of Daly City as a Police Officer on November 15, 1971. He was promoted to Detective in 1977 and later to Sergeant in 1985. He continued to excel in his career and was promoted to Lieutenant in 1994 and to the rank of Captain in 2000, where he continued to serve until his retirement; and

WHEREAS, MICHAEL SCOTT served in the US Army Reserves and attended San Francisco State University, where he received his Bachelors Degree. He continued his studies and obtained his P.O.S.T. Management Certificate in 1996; and

WHEREAS, MICHAEL SCOTT has, throughout his career, received twenty-nine Departmental commendations for exemplary service and numerous letters from residents, citizens and neighboring police agencies to whom he has provided services; and

WHEREAS, MICHAEL SCOTT was commended for his bravery in 1979 after chasing, exchanging gunfire with and capturing an armed bank robber. In 1985, he was commended by the Federal Bureau of Investigation for his involvement in a high profile homicide investigation, which received national attention; and


WHEREAS, MICHAEL SCOTT became certified in Command Hostage Negotiation, Tactical Command Operations and Special Weapons Tactics while a member and later, Commander of the Daly City Police Department's Tactical Response Team. He was also President of the Daly City Police Officers Association from 1980 - 1985, Director and Vice President of the California Organization for Police Officers and Sheriffs, President of the Daly City Police Athletics League, President of the Daly City - Quezon City Sister City Committee, and the President of the Daly City Host Lions Club, where he continues to serve today.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, does hereby recognize MICHAEL SCOTT for his leadership, his talent and the lasting legacy that he leaves among the ranks of the Daly City Police Department and within his community. His tireless devotion to his work has earned MICHAEL SCOTT the respect of all who know him.


