WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement on March 14, 2003, for Phase I of developing a web-based electronic application processing system for the One-E-App program for Medi-Cal and Healthy Families for children; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a First Amendment on May 13, 2003, to add Phase II to expand the existing system to include additional managed health programs; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to further amend the Agreement to enhance the capabilities of One-E-App by streamlining the re-enrollment process, which will allow County staff the ability to efficiently re-enroll children to the program without affecting their coverage.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ex is amended to read as follows:

- 2. Section 2: Services to be performed by Contractor is hereby amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the payments hereinafter set forth, Contractor shall perform services for County in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications set forth herein and in

Exhibits A, A1, A2, B, C, Attachments I, and Attachment II attached hereto and by this reference made a part thereof.

3. Section 4: Payments is hereby amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the services rendered in accordance with all terms, conditions and specifications set forth herein and in the Exhibits and Attachments hereto, County shall make payment to Contractor in the manner and amounts specified in the Exhibits and Attachments. In the event that the County makes any advance payments, Contractor agrees to refund any amounts in excess of the amount owed by the County at the time of contract termination. In no event shall total payment under this Agreement exceed \$448,5

4. Section 12: Governing Law and Severability is hereby amended to read as follows:

This Agreement, including the Exhibits and Attachments shall be governed, to the extent applicable, by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) and all Federal regulations promulgated there under, as amended, and incorporated by reference herein and as constructed in accordance with, the laws of the State of California (without giving effect to the choice of law principles thereof) with venue in the County of San Mateo Superior Court. If any provision of these terms is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, such provision shall be deemed modified to the extent necessary to render it enforceable, preserving to the fullest extent permissible the intent of the parties set forth herein.

6. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement dated March 14, 2003 and subsequent Amendments between the County and Contractor shall remain in full force and effect.

Expansion of the One-E-App Program Deloitte Consulting March 14, 2003 through June 30, 2004

Contractor's Responsibilities

Goal 1:Change the program so that the One-E-App system will generate a Healthy Kids printable renewal application where the left column displays the latest data collected from the applicant and the right column will be changed to allow for specific changes to the corresponding information on the left.

To make this change the Contractor will make the following modifications to the system:

- Develop a printable renewal form with the left column displaying the latest application data and right column allowing for specific changes;
- Work with San Mateo and Santa Clara counties to design a Healthy Kids paper renewal form that is easy to use for the applicants, which will be generated in PDF file format;
- Include the Rights and Declarations, and Consent to Share Data in the new paper renewal form, which will be signed manually by the applicant and then faxed into the system;
- Make the necessary modifications to the Optical Character Recognition module of the application;
- Develop screens that will allow the entering of the changes that were marked on the right hand side; (See Goal 2)
- Include a fax cover sheet for temporary document required for programs
 that applicants were eligible for in the prior year/period. The fax cover
 sheet will be similar to the one that is used in the regular application
 process and will display a generic list of documents that may be required
 in the renewal process;
- Develop functionality that keeps track of the number of paper renewal forms that were generated for mailing to the applicant. Requirements for the number of printable renewal forms and fax cover sheets that can be mailed to an applicant will need to be determined by the policy experts and programmed. This information must be provided by the Counties' at the Rapid Application Design Session;
- Develop functionality that allows the person entering data to search and select a new provider for the applying members;
- Develop functionality that will not allow duplicate renewal/change process to be started in One-E-App;

- Develop functionality that will provide workload management such as reminders, extensions, due dates for the printable renewal applications:
- Modify the Health Plan interface to accept records without any family contribution payments (i.e., check numbers, check date, amount and frequency); and
- Not make any changes to the Preliminary eligibility logic, Workflow and routing application, or to the Logic that determines funders for the Healthy Kids program.
- Goal 2: Allow users to have the ability in One-E-App to select an option on the Main Menu to data enter information collected from a completed paper application either for new enrollment or renewal on a few select screens. The current data entry process is different from the "Begin a New Application" process because it does not require the user to complete all seven steps of the One-E-App business process, rather all the information is captured on a limited number of screens.

To make this change the Contractor will make the following modifications to allow for the data entry of completed applications for enrollment or renewal:

- Develop screens that allow for the data entry of first time paper applications or renewals:
- Facilitate the rapid application design session for San Mateo County in collaboration with Santa Clara and Alameda Counties to validate the requirements for this enhancement;
- Enhance the features of the data entry screens to allow the following:
 - > Feature similar data edits and validations to the regular interview style application process;
 - Allow users the ability to "pend" applications that are not yet complete;
 - > Allow users to have a workload screen to view "pended' applications not yet complete;
 - > Applications entered through the data entry module to be tracked and flagged accordingly for reporting purposes;
 - > The data entry module will rectire the lettermination of preliminary eligibility for different programs that are included in One-E-App;
 - > The data entry module will also feature the collection of program specific information such as the selection of a provider for Healthy Kids; and
 - > Name Search will be programmed to run a search after all demographic data has been entered to indicate who is seeking assistance;
- Modify the Health Plan interface to accept records without any family contribution payments (i.e., check numbers, check date, amount and frequency).

For the purpose of completing both goals the Contractor will:

- Facilitate one three-hour rapid application design session with representatives of San Mateo and Santa Clara counties to validate the requirements for the renewal paper forms and data entry capability enhancements;
- Conduct design, development and the Integration _- _ the enhancements in their facility in Sacramento;
- Provide second level help desk support for the enhanced features in One-E-App; and
- Provide the Counties' with the resource, timeframe and cost impacts if the scope of the enhancements is altered by change in requirements or additional functionality requested.

Counties' Responsibilities

For the purpose of completing both goals the County of San Mateo in collaboration with the County of Santa Clara will:

- Coordinate the attendance of the subject matter experts for the rapid application design session. Attendees will include system users, program managers, and policy decision-makers of the programs and business processes;
- Share in the expense for the renewal and data entry enhancements as outlined in the Cost Estimate Section of this exhibit;
- Provide timely resolution of the County controlled issues that affect the project and plan schedule;
- Coordinate the necessary resources to complete thorough user acceptance testing of the enhancements:
- Be responsible for training and supporting staff that will use the enhanced features in the One-E-App system; and
- Provide first level help desk support for the enhanced features in the One-E-App system.

Cost:

Based on the modifications requested in Goals 1 and 2, the following cost includes development, testing and implementation.

The County shall pay contractor monthly for actual costs incurred upon receipt and approval of invoices. The full cost of services described in this exhibit shall not exceed \$6,500 without the County's prior approval. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the County acknowledges that Contractor has not been engaged to perform services on a fixed or not-to-exceed price basis.
