WHEREAS, in April 1929, Troop 156 was established to serve the needs of young men on the Peninsula and has been in continuous operation for the past seventy-five years; and

WHEREAS, in its seventy-five years, Troop 156 has served thousands of young men, with more than 100 earning the rank of Eagle Scout; and

WHEREAS, Troop 156 is recognized as one of the premier Boy Scout troops in the San Francisco Bay Area for having earned the Boy Scouts of America Quality Unit Award; and

WHEREAS, Troop 156 has maintained a superior outdoor program, including biennial High Adventure trips to such places as Philmont Scout Ranch in New Mexico, the Kenai Peninsula in Alaska, the Mt. Assiniboine Provincial Park near Banff Canada, the rainforests on the Island of Maui and exploring the San Juan Islands of Puget Sound aboard the historic schooner Adventuress; and


