PROCLAIMS

APRIL 2004 AS FAIR HOUSING MONTH

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County that the month of April be designated as FAIR HOUSING MONTH; and

WHEREAS, this year we celebrate the 36th Anniversary of the enactment of the Federal Fair Housing Act of 1968 (Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act), passed by Congress on April 11, 1968; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo strives to provide equal housing opportunities for all its residents as a goal in its general plan and has supported fair housing efforts to eliminate housing discrimination; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo supports state and federal protections against discrimination in the sale and rental of housing based on a person's race, religion, sex, national origin, marital status, the presence of children, sexual orientation, and physical or mental disability; and,


WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo supports the education of home owners, realtors, property managers, home buyers, and tenants regarding their rights and responsibilities under federal and state fair housing laws,



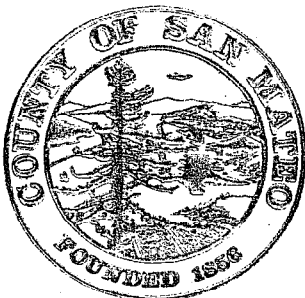
