WHEREAS, on April 27, 1998 the County of San Mateo and Opportunities

Industrialization Center West, as authorized by Resolution No. 62418, entered into a Lease

Agreement for the property located at 1200 O'Brien, Menlo Park, California; and

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2001 the County and the Landlord, as authorized by Resolution No. 64359, entered into the First Amendment for such premises; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to further amend the Lease by increasing the premises from 777 square feet to 897 square and the monthly rent from \$2,647.27 to \$2,917.30; and

WHEREAS, the Lease shall expire on April 30, 2006 as set forth in the First Amendment, and shall otherwise be on the same terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such Second Lease

Amendment and said Board, having examined and approved the Second Lease Amendment as to
