## RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO ESTABLISHING APPROPRIATION LIMITS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004-05

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS,** on November 6, 1979, California voters passed Proposition 4, an initiative to restrict government spending by establishing limits on the annual appropriations of local agencies;

WHEREAS, Proposition 4 added Article XIIIB to the California State constitution; (commencing with Section 7900) to Title I of the Government Code prescribing procedures to be used in implementing Article XIIIB;

WHEREAS, Article XIIIB of the California Constitution was amended by Proposition 111;
WHEREAS, Government Code Section 7910 requires local jurisdictions to establish by
resolution their Appropriation Limit each year for the following fiscal year; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors that the Appropriation Limit for the County of San Mateo and certain Board governed special districts for the 2004-05 fiscal year shall be \$312,216,678; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the documentation used in the computation of the aforementioned Appropriation Limit be made available to the public for review in the County Controller's Office.
