

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA PROCLAMATION DESIGNATING JULY 4, 2004 AS

COYOTE POINT YACHT CLUB DAY IN CELEBRATION OF THEIR DIAMOND JUBILEE

PROCLAIMED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, we celebrate the 75th Anniversary of the COYOTE POINT YACHT CLUB; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo recognizes the history of the COYOTE POINT YACHT CLUB and its original formation on July 20, 1941; and

WHEREAS, the COYOTE POINT YACHT CLUB successfully merged with the Palo Alto Yacht Club in 1997; and

WHEREAS, the COYOTE POINT YACHT CLUB is recognized for the youth sailing program, in which youngsters from the entire community are given the opportunity to learn the fundamentals of sailing; and

WHEREAS, the COYOTE POINT YACHT CLUB sponsors a variety of water activities including Junior Sailing Program, cruising program, educational programs, South Bay Yacht Racing Association program, member activities of MORA, NPCA, PICYA, RBOC, SBYRA yachting associations and involvement with Save-the-Bay environmental activities; and

WHEREAS, the COYOTE POINT YACHT CLUB promotes water safety, environmentally sound boating practices and appreciation for the San Francisco Bay's ecology,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that this Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County, hereby designates July 4, 2004 as COYOTE POINT YACHT CLUB DAY in San Mateo County and encourages citizens and community organizations to celebrate its existence and success that has enriched the county for seventy-five years.
