

SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO
AND
FIRE NET SIX
For Public Safety Communications/Dispatch

THIS IS AN AMENDMENT to the existing Agreement entered into on June 21, 1994, by and between FIRE NET SIX, a joint powers entity, hereinafter called "FIRE NET SIX", and the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "County".

WHEREAS, the parties have previously entered in an Agreement for public safety communications services (Resolutions 58386, dated June 21, 1994) for a 10 year term concluding June 30, 2004; and

WHEREAS, both parties have subsequently adopted the amendment to this Agreement extending the term to June 30, 2005, modifying contractual payments, and certain other operational changes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES that the existing Agreement is hereby further amended, by reference to Sections of the original Agreement and its Exhibits, and incorporating or replacing certain modifications approved in the agreement as follows:

AGREEMENT AMENDMENTS

Section 1 of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Contract Term. The term of this Agreement shall be July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005, subject to the termination by either party, with 180 days written notice. If the contract is terminated, notification must take place in the month of December.

Section 2 of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Payments. In consideration of the communications services rendered in accordance with all terms, conditions and specifications set forth herein, the rates for services are as follows for the one year of this contract. Rates are established pursuant to negotiated salary increases of dispatch personnel.

The following rate is amended to read as follows:
July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005 – \$446,783 reflecting a 4% increase from FY03-04.

It is understood that the rate increase during the term of this contract is commensurate with the Communications Dispatchers negotiated labor contract increase for wages as defined in the MOU, effective November 9, 2004.

Section 7 of the Agreement is amended as follows:

Section 7. Non-Discrimination. No person shall, on the grounds of age (over 40), ancestry, creed, color, disability, marital status, medical condition, national origin, political or religious affiliation, race, sex, sexual orientation or any non-job-related criteria be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits, or be subjected to discrimination under this agreement.

In all other respects, the agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
