Treatment Definitions:

Slurry Seal: a mixture of asphaltic emulsion and sand sized aggregate applied to the existing road surface.

Cape Seal: an application of asphaltic emulsion, immediately followed by an application of small rocks called chips to the roadway surface – followed by a slurry seal (a mixture of asphaltic emulsion and sand sized aggregate) approximately one week later to the exiting road surface.

Resurface: an application of a thin layer of asphalt to the existing road surface.

Notes:

(*) Various road projects outlined above may be impacted by budget impacts.

(a) Projects proposed in this area do not qualify for “streamline” bidding procedures

(b) Roads in this area have either recently been resurfaced or currently do not need to be resurfaced

(c) Road maintenance for this area is “repair only” based on property owner survey and Board Resolution

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Treatment Definitions:

Slurry Seal: a mixture of asphaltic emulsion and sand sized aggregate applied to the existing road surface.

Cape Seal: an application of asphaltic emulsion (road oil), immediately followed by an application of small rocks called chips to the roadway surface – followed by a slurry seal (a mixture of asphaltic emulsion and sand sized aggregate) approximately one week later to the road surface.

Resurface: an application of a thin layer of asphalt concrete to the road surface.

Note:

1. Treatment types for various roads may be changed during the design phase to address topographic and/or traffic issues.
2. Actual construction schedules may vary from project to project depending on available funding.
