WHEREAS, PETER MARCHI helped evacuate Pescadero residents from their flooded homes during the 1982 flood and again in floods in 1995 and 1996; and,

WHEREAS, PETER MARCHI married his wife Sherry on August 11, 1984 and is the proud father of their son Eric and daughter Melissa; and

WHEREAS, PETER MARCHI was assistant coach for the Pescadero 7th and 8th grade girls basketball team and served as Cub Scout Ranger from 2001-2003; and,

WHEREAS, PETER MARCHI coached AYSO Youth Soccer 1990 to 1996; Little Kickers AYSO Youth Soccer 1997 to 2001; and has now been coaching and managing Half Moon Bay Little League since 2001; and,

WHEREAS, PETER MARCHI has served on the San Mateo County Agriculture Advisory Board for 3 years, has served on the Farm Supply Board, and has joined the San Mateo County Farm Bureau Board of Directors;
