

AMENDMENT NO. 7
TO AGREEMENT NO. PR-0272 BETWEEN

SAN MATEO COUNTY
AND
THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LELAND STANFORD JUNIOR UNIVERSITY

This **Amendment #7** is made and entered into between The Board of Trustees of Leland Stanford Junior University, a body having corporate powers under the laws of the State of California, hereafter referred to as "Stanford" and San Mateo County, hereafter referred to as "Contractor".

- Stanford is the recipient of Grant No. **3 U01 AI27666** from The National Institutes of Health (NIH) (Prime Sponsor) for the project titled "AIDS Clinical Trials Unit - Stanford University."

NOW THEREFORE, Contractor agrees that it will furnish the services called for herein, and Stanford agrees that it will pay Contractor therefore in the amounts, at the times, and under the terms and conditions enumerated in this Contract.

1. Article 1. STATEMENT OF WORK

Contractor shall provide research services to support Stanford's NIH-sponsored project titled: "AIDS Clinical Trials Unit - Stanford University". Contractor shall perform patient screening and provide follow-up care and data collection in Phase II/III anti-HIV therapy protocols as well as therapy protocols for infectious malignancies. These services will occur at Willow Road Clinic and Edison Clinic, both subsidiaries of San Mateo County. **Contractor Principal Investigator is Dennis Israelski and Stanford's Principal Investigator has changed to Andrew Zolopa.**

2. Article 2. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The period of performance shall be extended to December 31, 2005.

3. Article 3.a.2. ALLOWABLE COSTS AND PAYMENT

- Year 1 period of performance was January 1, 1998 through December 31, 1998 with a budget of \$53,544.00.
- Amendment #1 was for Year 2. The period of performance was January 1, 1999 through December 31, 1999 with a budget of \$18,287.00
- Amendment #2 was for Year 3. The period of performance was January 1, 2000 through December 31, 2000 with a budget of \$48,697.00.
- Amendment #3 was for Year 4. The period of performance was January 1, 2001 through December 31, 2001 with a budget of \$69,899.00.
- Amendment #4 was for Year 5. The period of performance was January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002 with a budget of \$142,266.00.
- Amendment #5 was for Year 6. The period of performance was January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003 with a budget of \$60,662.00.
- Amendment #6 was for Year 7. The period of performance was January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004 with a budget of \$47,763.00.
- **Amendment #6 is for Year 8. The period of performance is January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005 with a budget of \$44,234.00 (see Attachment A).**
- Total funding for this agreement is \$485,352.00.
- Carry over of an unobligated balance into the next budget period require prior approval.
