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AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE SAN MATEO
COMMISSION ON PUBLICLY ASSISTED MEDICAL CARE
(HEALTH COMMISSION)

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California,
ORDAINS as follows

SECTION 1.

Section 2.68.020 of Chapter 2.68 of Title 2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2.68.020 Membership of commission.

(a) The Commission shall consist of nine (9) voting members, who shall either be legal residents of the County of San Mateo, or shall work for an employer whose primary place of business is located in the County of San Mateo.

(b) Members of the Commission should have an abiding commitment to, and interest in quality publicly assisted health care delivery systems.

(c) The nine voting members shall include:

1. Two members of the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors;
2. The County Manager or his designee;
3. A physician;
4. Three public members, including:
 - a. A beneficiary or representative of beneficiaries served by the Commission; and
 - b. A representative of the senior and/or minority communities in San

Mateo County; and

- c. A public member at large;
- 5. A representative of San Mateo County General Hospital physicians; and
- 6. A pharmacist;
- (d) Commissioners shall be appointed by majority vote of the Board of Supervisors and shall serve at the pleasure thereof.
- (e) Except as provided in subsection (f), all Commissioners appointed by the Board shall serve terms of office of four (4) years. At the conclusion of a term, a member may be reappointed to another term. Unless specific exception is made by the Board of Supervisors or state law, no appointed member appointed by the Board of Supervisors may serve more than three complete terms.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days from the passage date thereof.
