Notice is hereby given pursuant to Government Code Section 50050-50053 et seq., there is currently on deposit with the Treasurer of the County of San Mateo, in a fund entitled "Unknown Heirs", the total sum of \$49,705.87. This money was received from the San Mateo County Public Administrator's Office and has remained unclaimed in the Treasury of the County of San Mateo for three years. The Public Administrator's Office has been unable to locate the persons entitled to any of said monies after the exercise of due diligence, and it is necessary and desirable to provide for the escheat of said monies to the County of San Mateo pursuant to Section 50050-50053 et seq., of the Government Code.
