Recommendation

Adopt a resolution authorizing the President of the Board to execute an agreement with The Regents of the University of California to provide plastic surgery services.

The agreement contributes to this commitment and goal by providing specialty services plastic surgery services to county patients, specifically in the area of noncosmetic post-traumatic, post-cancer, and hand reconstructive care.

Background / Discussion

Plastic Surgery services are provided under the general direction of the Medical Director of San Mateo Medical Center. Such care includes professional plastic

surgery services, specifically in the area of non-cosmetic post-traumatic, post-cancer, and hand reconstructive care. The Regents of the University of California provides plastic surgery services. For the past two years, they have provided these services as a Contractor to the San Mateo Medical Center.

This contract maintains continued access to the highest standards of medical quality, for which UCSF is known, as well as a continued model for providing professional medical services here at SMMC. Monitoring and evaluation of the quality of services provided by contractor will be accomplished through peer review by the Quality Assurance Committee and the Chief Executive Committee of the Medical Staff.

Term and Fiscal Impact

The base contracted rate of \$9058.33 per month is the same as last year, but the contract term has been extended from twelve months to thirteen months to coincide with the respective San Mateo County and UCSF fiscal year periods. The term of the agreement is thirteen months from June 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005. The maximum amount for the term of the agreement increased from \$152,100 for a twelve-month period to \$161,158.33 for the thirteen-month period. Funding for FY2004-05 is included in the Adopted Budget for San Mateo Medical Center.
