I, Margaret Ho Huey, purchased two vacant lots in Daly City on September 23, 1999: parcel numbers 006-206-080 & 006-206-090 (Deed # 1999-163255)


The Assessor's Office incorrectly put the full-assessed value of \$196,000 on parcel 006-206-080. In all the time that I have owned the property, I have paid all the bills received on this parcel in a timely manner. Since I was paying on the assessed value based on my purchase price, I always assumed that I was paying for both parcels in the one bill I received each year. When I did notice the error in July of 2004, I immediately notified the Assessor's Office and was assured that it was their mistake and they would correct the matter by splitting the value for both parcels.

I thought the matter had been taken care of until I received a "Notice of Power to Sell Tax Defaulted Property" from the Tax Collectors' Office dated February 18, 2005. Unfortunately the purchase date was not within the 4 year Statute of Limitations, and I was charged for the 1999-2000 and 2000-2001 bills on parcel 006-206-090 based on the old owner's value plus penalty charges in the amount of \$3,889.63. I have already paid, based on my full value, for these two years as billed on parcel 006-206-080.

Since I have paid everything I owe on these properties and this is clearly the Assessor's mistake, I am asking to be refunded the \$3,889.63, a bill that should never have been mine.


I immigrated to the U.S.A. in November 1951. I have been in this country more than half a century, 54 years. During this time I bought and sold about 10 properties. I always paid off all loans and taxes. Within these 54 years I never owed one penny. You may check up on this, if you wish. My tax I.D. number is: 552-44-8008.

I don't know what happened in this recent situation. It seems there was an error somewhere. Approximately the same time I bought both lots number 25 and number 26, which had the one old house on it. The house is demolished now. There is only one tax sheet statement for lots number 25 and 26. For lot # 27, there is one separate tax statement. I received only one sheet for lots 28 and 29. In total I received three tax statements; and I paid all these on time without fail. Unfortunately, I didn't receive the tax statement you talked about. If I didn't get this in the mail, how would I know how much I have to pay? I always thought lots 28 and 29 were just like lots 25 and 26, which were on one statement.

I have worked several years as an employee and later on as a proprietor of my own restaurant and small apartment since 1953 to 1996. I worked very hard, every day 12 hours to 15 hours 7 days a week to be able to support myself and have a decent and honest living. At that time I was still young and I felt healthy enough to work hard. Now sometimes I think about all the years I devoted to my work in the past and tears drop from my eyes.

Right now I'm still working part time and continue to pay taxes. I just don't know how to quit working. All these 54 years I have been involved in the restaurant business and owned properties. Over the 54 years that I have worked in total I probably already paid about one million dollars in taxes. Since I paid so much already, why should I deceive anyone by not acknowledging this one statement? Please help me straighten up this error. I appreciate your cooperation. Thank you very much.
