RECOMMENDATION:

Appoint Sandy Reiter to represent the AMR Paramedic member seat, to a term expiring March 31, 2006.

BACKGROUND:

The EMCC bylaws specify the membership composition to include one certified and accredited San Mateo County EMT-Paramedic, who shall be employed as a field care EMT-paramedic by the countywide exclusive emergency ambulance contractor.

The paramedic who has been serving in this role, Scott Englemen, no longer wishes to serve. The Union representing San Mateo AMR paramedics is the National EMS Association (NEMSA). Attached is NEMSA's letter nominating paramedic Sandra Reiter for appointment to the EMCC.
