WHEREAS, the Agreement was an estimate of services to be needed and required based on the program and the scope has subsequently increased; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase the amount and time of the contract to continue and complete the building commissioning;

NOW THEREFORE, the County and Contractor agree to: Increase the maximum not-to-exceed total payment for additional services of Contractor by \$36,720, from \$234,111 to \$270,831 per attached Exhibit A and extend the term of the contract from March 1, 2007 to June 30, 2007.

In all other respects, the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
