Contractor and its lead evaluators, Embry Howell and Genevieve Kenney, will subcontract with the following organizations and their lead evaluators:

1. Mathematica Policy Research (Martha Kovac and Christopher Trenholm) for \$461,306 to design and implement the client survey;

4. Schedule B, Section A is amended to read as follows:

Contractor shall be paid a total of One Million Three Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand Five Hundred and Thirty Eight Dollars (\$1,378,538) for the term of the agreement.

5. Schedule B, Section B is amended to read as follows:
