(iv) an approximately 7,600-square-foot parking garage located at 255 Upland Road, Redwood

City, California, and (v) a radiology and laboratory facility, located in leased space at 2900

Whipple Street, Suite #100, Redwood City, California. Interested persons wishing to express

their views on the issuance of the Bonds or on the nature and location of the facilities proposed

to be financed will be given an opportunity to do so at the public hearing or may, prior to the
