# AGREEMENT BETWEEN SAN MATEO MEDICAL CENTER AND SEQUOIA HEALTHCARE DISTRICT FOR THE CARE OF UNINSURED PATIENTS AT THE FAIR OAKS CLINICS

#### Purpose

The Board of Directors of Sequoia Healthcare District (SHD) has granted funding to San Mateo Medical Center (SMMC) to help offset the cost of providing medical care to uninsured patients at the Fair Oaks Clinics over a two-year period, in order to assist the clinics in achieving the goal of financial stability.

### Scope of Service

SMMC will use the grant funds solely for the purpose of providing outpatient primary medical care, specialty medical care, and ancillary services to indigent and uninsured patients of the Fair Oaks Clinics who reside within the of Sequoia Healthcare District.

#### Amount of Funding

The total amount of this grant will not exceed \$3,310,700, payable as \$1,655,350 per year, for two years.

#### Term of Grant

The grant is for a two-year period commencing on July 1, 2006, and ending on June 30, 2008.

#### Method of Payment

SHD will make grant payments to SMMC on a quarterly basis. SMMC will invoice SHD within 30 days after the end of each quarter of the grant term.

### Reporting

Accompanying the quarterly invoice will be reports indicating the volume of uninsured patient visits served with SHD funding, and an itemization by line item of clinic expenses adjusted to reflect the amounts expended on uninsured patient care. Additionally, on an annual basis, SMMC will provide SHD information about health benefits that were achieved as a result of the grant, and any other information that will enable the Board of SHD and residents of the District to understand the effect and value of the grant funding. On September 20, 2006, Sequoia Healthcare District's Board of Directors approved a grant to San Mateo Medical Center in the total amount of \$3,310,700, payable over two years, to supplement the cost for uninsured care at the Fair Oaks Clinic to assist the Clinic in their goal of achieving financial stability over the two-year grant period, as described in your letter of September 12, 2006, to the Board of Directors.

Accordingly, Sequoia Healthcare District will make grant payments to the Medical Center on a quarterly basis, not to exceed \$1,655,350 per year. The grant is for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2007 and June 30, 2008. The Medical Center will invoice Sequoia Healthcare District, on a quarterly basis, to include reports indicating the volume of uninsured patients being served with District funding and an itemization, by line item, of the expenses of the Clinic, adjusted to demonstrate the amounts expended on uninsured patient care. On an annual basis, the Medical Center will provide to Sequoia Healthcare District information as to what public health benefits were achieved as a result of having the grant, and any other information that will enable Sequoia Healthcare District's Board and the public to understand the effect and value of the grant funding.

These funds are to be used solely to support the Medical Center for indigent and uninsured residents of Sequoia Healthcare District seeking care at the Fair Oaks Medical Clinic for outpatient primary medical care, ancillary services (laboratory, pharmacy, radiology), and specialty medical care.
