### SECOND AMENDMENT

THIS AMENDMENT is made as of **May 15, 2007**, in San Francisco, California, by and between the **County of San Mateo** ("the County"), and the **City and County of San Francisco**, a municipal corporation ("the City"), acting by and through the San Francisco Department of Emergency Management, Division of Emergency Services.

#### RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City and the County have entered into the Agreement (as defined below); and

WHEREAS, the City and the County desire to modify the Agreement on the terms and conditions set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City and the County agree as follows:

- **1. Definitions**. The following definitions shall apply to this Amendment:
- (a) Agreement. The term "Agreement" shall mean the Agreement dated March 15, 2006 between the City and the County, titled "Agreement Between the City and County of San Francisco and the County of San Mateo for the Distribution of FY 2005 UASI Regional Funds," as amended by the First Amendment, dated July 15, 2006.
- **(b) Other Terms**. Terms used and not defined in this Amendment shall have the meanings assigned to such terms in the Agreement.
- **2. Modifications to the Agreement**. The Agreement is hereby modified as follows:
  - (a) Section 3.1. Section 3.1, "Duration of Term," of the Agreement currently reads as follows:

The term of this Agreement shall commence on <u>MARCH 15, 2006</u> and shall end at 11:59 p.m. San Francisco time on <u>DECEMBER 31, 2006</u>.

Such section is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

The term of this Agreement shall commence on <u>MARCH 15, 2006</u> and shall end at 11:59 p.m. San Francisco time on <u>DECEMBER 31, 2007</u>.

**(b) Section 3.2.** Section 3.2, "Maximum Amount of Funds," of the Agreement currently reads as follows:

In no event shall the amount of Funds disbursed hereunder exceed <u>ONE</u> <u>MILLION ONE HUNDRED FIFTY TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED</u> Dollars (\$1,152,200.00).

Such section is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

# In no event shall the amount of Funds disbursed hereunder exceed **ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED** Dollars (\$1,202,200.00).

- (c) Appendix A. Appendix A, "Authorized Expenditures," is hereby amended in its entirety and attached in both its current and its amended form.
- **3. Effective Date**. Each of the modifications set forth in Section 2 shall be effective on and after the date of this Amendment.
- **4. Legal Effect**. Except as expressly modified by this Amendment, all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
