SUBJECT: Appointments to the Fatherhood Collaborative Advisory Board

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that all existing members of the Fatherhood Collaborative of San Mateo County be appointed to the governing board of the newly created Fatherhood Collaborative Advisory Board. The current governing board comprises 14 members, with one open seat. The appointments, as listed below, are divided into two groups to stagger the terms.

VISION ALIGNMENT:

Commitment: Realize the potential of our diverse population.

Goal: Civic engagement-including voting, public service, charitable giving, volunteerism, and participation in public discussions of important issues-is uniformly high among the diverse population.

BACKGROUND:

On September 25, 2007, this Board created the Fatherhood Collaborative Advisory Board as the 30th advisory body to the Board. Prior to this, the Fatherhood Collaborative functioned as a semi-independent entity. Participants in the Collaborative have included members of this Board, the Child Care Coordinating Council, the Service League, employees of County departments and members of the general public.

DISCUSSION:

Pursuant to the resolution creating the advisory board, the members of the governing board have two-year terms based on the calendar year. In order to stagger the terms, the first group of appointees below will serve one-year terms, expiring December 31, 2008, and the second group below will serve two-year terms, expiring December 31, 2009. If appointed, the membership and terms will be as follows:
