WHEREAS, Section 1797.224 of the Health and Safety Code permits local Emergency Medical Services (EMS) agencies to create one or more exclusive operating areas (EOA) for ambulance services as long as a competitive process is utilized to select the provider; and

WHEREAS, in 1976, San Mateo County created a countywide EOA, with the exception of the City of South San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, the current contract with American Medical Response West for emergency ambulance service ends in June 2009; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board for its consideration a

Request for Proposals for emergency ambulance service, whereby an ambulance
service provider shall provide emergency ambulance services within the County EOA;
and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with this RFP and has examined

and approved its issuance:

Ambulance Services within County's exclusive operating area.
