List of Activities for Hiller Aviation Museum's 2008 Vertical Challenge Air Show at the San Carlos Airport.

1. Fly-in and static display of military and civilian helicopters including the Chinook CH-47, Super Stallion CH-53, HH-60 Pave Hawk, Sky Crane and Apache AH-64
2. Helicopter rides
3. The sale of food, beer, wine, tee shirts, memorabilia and other items from participating groups
4. Parachute jumpers
5. Aerobatic air show performances by the Red-Bull helicopter, "ShowCopters", and Eddie Andreini's Super-Stearman
6. Helicopter and parachute jumper pyrotechnic demonstrations
7. Tethered hot air balloon rides
8. Coast Guard search and rescue helicopter demonstration
9. Fly-by demonstrations by C-5A, F-117, B-2, 747, C-130 and FA18 aircraft
10. Military helicopter demonstrations
11. Harrier jet and V-22 Osprey tilt-rotor hover and flight demonstrations (will not land)
12. A car drop from a helicopter onto the dirt infield area of the airport from a height of approximately 200 feet. The vehicle's gas-tank, glass and all fluids will be removed prior to the drop
13. Helicopter water drop demonstration
14. Nascar vs. helicopter runway drag race
15. A pre-event "Wild Brew Yonder" dinner for 400 to 500 guests at the Museum on the Friday night before the event which includes an air show which is scheduled to last for approximately 45-minutes
16. A post-event static display of military aircraft on the Sunday following the event
