| Coastside Hope | San Mateo County coast, including Montara, Pescadero and Half Moon Bay | Support for part-time case manager who provides counseling, food and shelter referral services | \$40,000 |
| CORA (Community Overcoming Relationship Abuse) | San Mateo County | Emergency shelter for domestic violence victims | \$62,500 |
| El Concilio | East Palo Alto and Menlo Park | Information and referral along with emergency housing and food assistance in collaboration with One East Palo Alto | \$50,000 |
| Fair Oaks | Redwood City, north Fair Oaks, Woodside, Atherton and Portola Valley | Support for half-time salary for a human services assistant and additional shelter and emergency financial assistance | \$40,600 |
| HIP Housing | San Mateo County | Emergency shelter program administrator and case manager for Self-Sufficiency Program, which offers shelter to families who are homeless or at risk of being homeless. | \$40,000 |
| InnVision | Santa Clara and San Mateo counties, from San Jose to Menlo Park | Short-term stabilization and transitional housing for low-income and homeless individuals and families | \$175,000 |
| Legal Aid Society of San Mateo County | San Mateo County | Provide emergency food and shelter stipends to clients as well as legal counsel and representation for food stamp eligibility and eviction prevention | \$47,675 |
| North Peninsula Neighborhood | Brisbane, San Bruno and South San Francisco | Food delivery and vouchers in addition to emergency shelter and rental and utility assistance | \$50,000 |
| Pacifica Resource Center | Pacifica-Daly City region | Support for three-quarter time case worker for emergency assistance and homeless prevention | \$42,954 |
| Samaritan House | Millbrae through San Carlos | Support for food and nutrition program | \$74,200 |
| Samaritan House Safe Harbor | San Mateo County | Support for Safe Harbor Homeless Shelter, which provides emergency and transitional shelter | \$75,000 |
