### **SUMMARY OF PREVIOUS BOARD ACTIONS AUTHORIZING FUNDING TO BE USED FOR VARIOUS PARKS DEPARTMENT PROJECTS:**

1. Adopted Resolution Number 069376 on April 22, 2008, which authorized funding of \$100,000 from Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3.
2. Adopted Resolution Number 068263 on September 12, 2006, which authorized funding of \$170,000 from the California State Lands Commission – Command Oil Spill.
3. Adopted Resolution Number 068148 on July 18, 2006, which authorized funding from Federal Highway Administration Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Improvement Program.
4. Adopted Resolution Number 067572 on September 27, 2005, which authorized funding of \$220,590 from California State Parks and Recreation via Federal Highway Administration Recreational Trail Program (RTP).
5. Adopted Resolution Number 067028 on November 9, 2004, which authorized funding of \$100,000 from the California Resources Agency Environmental Enhancement Mitigation (EEM) Program.
