A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE CERTIFICATE OF THE CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER AND THE STATEMENT OF ELECTION RESULTS AS DETERMINED BY THE OFFICIAL CANVASS OF THE VOTES CAST IN THE SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTION CONDUCTED ON MAY 5, 2009 BY MAIL

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Chief Elections Officer has completed the official canvass of the votes cast in the Jefferson Elementary School District, Woodside Elementary School District, and the San Carlos School District in the Special School District conducted by mail on May 5, 2009, and has prepared in accordance with law an abstract or statement of votes polled at said election, and has presented a certified copy of said statement to this Board; and

WHEREAS the Chief Elections Officer will submit to the governing boards of the Jefferson Elementary School District, Woodside Elementary School District, and the San Carlos School District a copy of the certified results and the Certificate of the Election so that it shall declare that the votes cast for and against the ballot measures listed below, resulted in their passage or defeat pursuant to Elections Code §15400; and

WHEREAS the Chief Elections Officer will deliver to the districts a certificate of

election, signed and authorized by the Chief Elections Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND HEREBY ORDERED that the Deputy Clerk of the Board shall enter upon the minutes of this meeting of this Board of Supervisors said statement of votes polled at said election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said statement of votes polled shall be and is hereby adopted as the official vote of said election; and that it shall declare that the votes cast for and against the following ballot measures resulted in their passage or defeat
