**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, under Government Code sections 25257 and 25258, the Board of Supervisors can discharge the County from continued efforts to collect funds owed to the County; and

WHEREAS, the accounts presented totaling \$17,999,999.99 for fiscal year 2007-08 for discharge from accountability for the collection thereof are too small to justify the cost of collection, the likelihood of collection does not warrant the expense involved, or the amount thereof has been otherwise lawfully compromised of adjusted; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, desires to terminate any further efforts in the collection of these accounts.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Revenue Services Division of the Tax Collector-Treasurer-Revenue Services

Department is discharged from accountability of the accounts presented.
