In 2009, after the completion of two improvement projects, the Department of Public Works reviewed the conditions that exist in the vicinity of the crosswalk.

Staff collected the following data:

Description	Data	Recommended Warrants	Meets/Does not Meet Warrant
Number of pedestrians crossing	6 pedestrians 6 bicycles in a six hour period	Minimum 20 per hour or 15 for elderly/child	Does not meet warrants
Type of roadway	Arterial/collector 4 lanes plus 1 left turn centerlane. No raised median	For four or more lanes without a center median, a marked crosswalk requires a traffic signal or other advance warning treatments.	Does not meet warrants
Traffic Volume	ADT 16,000	Greater than 12,000 ADT, therefore a marked crosswalk requires traffic signal or other advance warning treatments.	Does not meet warrants
Speed of vehicles	85% of the vehicles traveling on this segment of road travel between 35 and 39 mph. The posted speed limit is 35 mph.	Less than 40 mph.	Meets warrants
Visibility	Sight distance is good.	Minimum 250 feet clear each way	Meets warrants
