This contract amendment will be valid and enforceable subject to authorization and appropriation of sufficient DMC funds to ADP budget authority. If sufficient authorization and appropriation of DMC funds to ADP's budget authority is denied, a reduction of DMC funding will be made to your contract.

If the agreed-upon contract provisions cannot be met, the County must immediately notify ADP in writing. Failure to provide such notification may require ADP to invoke its right to terminate the contract in order to ensure that services are provided with reasonable promptness.



The requirements for processing the enclosed contract amendment include the following:

- > Obtain a resolution, board minutes, order, motion, or ordinance from your County Board of Supervisors (BOS) which specifically approves and authorizes execution of this amendment.
- ➤ Have the individual authorized by the County BOS to sign four (4) Standard Agreement Amendment forms. Include authority to sign if other than the Chairman of the Board signs.
- > Return three (3) signed Standard Agreement Amendment forms with the authorization to:
