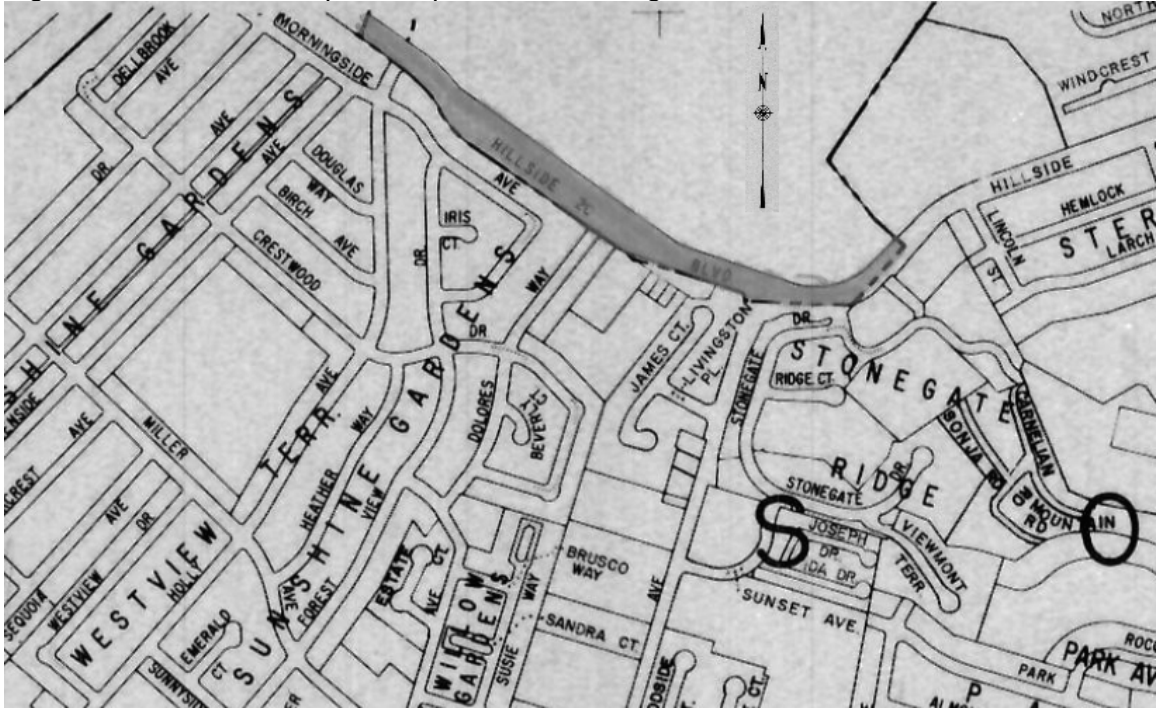


Attachment A – Map of Proposed Traffic Control Device Locations and Public Input Summary

Agency Comments:

Town of Colma City Engineer, 11/20/09, Objects to increase in speed limit because concerned for public safety, received requests to reduce speed limit, request that we perform further studies

Petitions:

Petition #1: 11/7/09, 40 people signed, Strongly opposed to the speed limit increase, there have been accidents, there are schools nearby, concerned for pedestrians and students at nearby schools

Petition #2: 11/17/09, 30 people signed, Stop speed limit increase on Hillside between Lincoln and Evergreen, reduce speed limit between Lincoln and Lawndale to 25 mph, "rezone Hillside Blvd. to be changed from 'unincorporated' to 'residential' between Lincoln and Lawndale"

Petition #3 11/18/09, 38 people signed, Stop speed limit increase on Hillside between Lincoln and Evergreen, reduce speed limit between Lincoln and Lawndale to 25 mph, “rezone Hillside Blvd. to be changed from ‘unincorporated’ to ‘residential’ between Lincoln and Lawndale” (additional sheets of Petition #2 by separate cover)
