<b>Location, Project Limits, Description, Scope of Work, Legislative Description</b>					
The project is in various cities in San Mateo County. This project will restripe existing bike lanes, install bicycle lane pavement markings, remove and replace bike signage, install new bike signage, restripe or install new pedestrian crosswalks and pedestrian crossing legends, and install aggregate base backing along the outside edge of paved bike lanes.

<b>Purpose and Need</b>					
Restriping existing faded bike lanes and placement of bicycle pavement markings will make them more visible and safer to bicyclists. Removing and replacing existing bike related signage with signage with increased retroreflectivity will allow bicyclists and motorists to see the signs better in the dark. The signs help visually elevate the prominence of the bike lanes on the road, further defining the cyclist's space. Installing new retroreflective bike signage will inform bicyclists of the bike lanes and of their beginning and end. Restriping existing faded crosswalks will make them more visible and safer for pedestrians. Installing aggregate base backing along the outside paved edge of bike lanes will allow bicyclists to ride safely next to an even/flush surface along gravel shoulder areas.					
<b>Project Benefits</b>					
This project will increase the safety of bicyclists and pedestrians and makes the statement that bicycling and walking is important to San Mateo County and that the County is taking great strides to improve the experience of bicyclists and pedestrians. The bike signs and striping help visually elevate the prominence of the bike lanes on the roads, further defining the cyclist's space and helping differentiate the road space from that which motorists feel free to use.
