Proposed Administrative Fee for the Recycling and Diversion of Construction and Demolition Debris Ordinance

The County of San Mateo Board of Supervisors will consider the adoption of a resolution imposing an Administrative Fee for the expenses incurred in administering the Recycling and Diversion of Construction and Demolition Debris Ordinance. Chapter 4.105 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code allows for the establishment of an Administrative Fee by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.

Previously, there has been no fee. The proposed new fee of \$95 per Waste Management Plan submitted for review, reflects the County's cost of providing this service.
