**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A COUNTY INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT
POLICY, WHICH SHALL SERVE AS A POLICY DOCUMENT RELATIVE TO
PESTICIDE MANAGEMENT ON LAND EITHER OWNED OR MANAGED BY THE
COUNTY OF SAN MATEO**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted a Municipal Regional Permit (Permit) on October 14, 2009; and

WHEREAS, agencies within the San Francisco Bay Area are mandated to meet the requirements of the Permit; and

WHEREAS, one of the requirements of the Permit is the adoption of an Integrated Pest Management Policy; and

WHEREAS, affected County of San Mateo Departments have met and collaboratively developed an Integrated Pest Management Policy for the County of San Mateo, which establishes goals of protecting the health and safety of County employees and the general public; protects the environment and water quality; and provides sustainable pest control solutions through the reduced used of pesticides on County owned or managed property; and

WHEREAS, the Directors of the various Departments impacted by the adoption

a County Integrated Pest Management Policy recommend the Board's approval of that policy, and the Board has considered the policy and concurs with the recommendation.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the County Integrated Pest Management Policy be adopted by this Board as the County-wide policy document relating to pesticide use on land either owned or managed by the County of San Mateo.
