Statement of Work: Contract with San Mateo Medical Center

Current Period of Contract: 5/1/10-04/30/11

Total Period of Contract: 02/01/09-10/30/12

Scope of Work:

The San Mateo Medical Center (SMMC) contract will allow the Vivamos Activos Project (RO1- HL 089 448; SPO#38148) to fulfill its scope of work. The contract includes the payment of SMMC personnel to perform work on the Vivamos Activos Project and to collaborate on the development and dissemination of the project intervention. The specific functions of SMMC personnel and the locations of facilities are described in the budget justification below. The detailed budget for the contract is located in a separate Excel file. The contract involves handling of protected health information and SMMC will ensure their employees have met HIPAA and human subjects training requirements. Recruitment and intervention visits for the project will take place at the SMMC Fair Oaks Adult Clinic.

Deliverables:

Personnel supported through this subcontract are expected to contribute to the Vivamos Activos Project as described in the budget justification. The financial manager Jonathan Mesinger will provide itemized invoice billing. The personnel will attend weekly meetings and help coordinate relations between NCDS, Fair Oaks Adult Clinic and Stanford personnel. Health educators, to-be-named will attend weekly project meetings and contribute to patient recruitment, study intervention, and patient retention as described in the budget justification. The community health workers will report directly to the subaward lead physician and principal investigator and through dotted-line reporting to Rebecca Drieling, the project Research Director. They will adhere to the study protocol and will complete data collection forms for the participants they case manage.
