The County reserves the right to withhold payment if the County determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. In no event shall the County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$1,260,250).
