Figure 1. Proposed New Traffic Control Devices –Crosswalk at 3249 Alpine Road

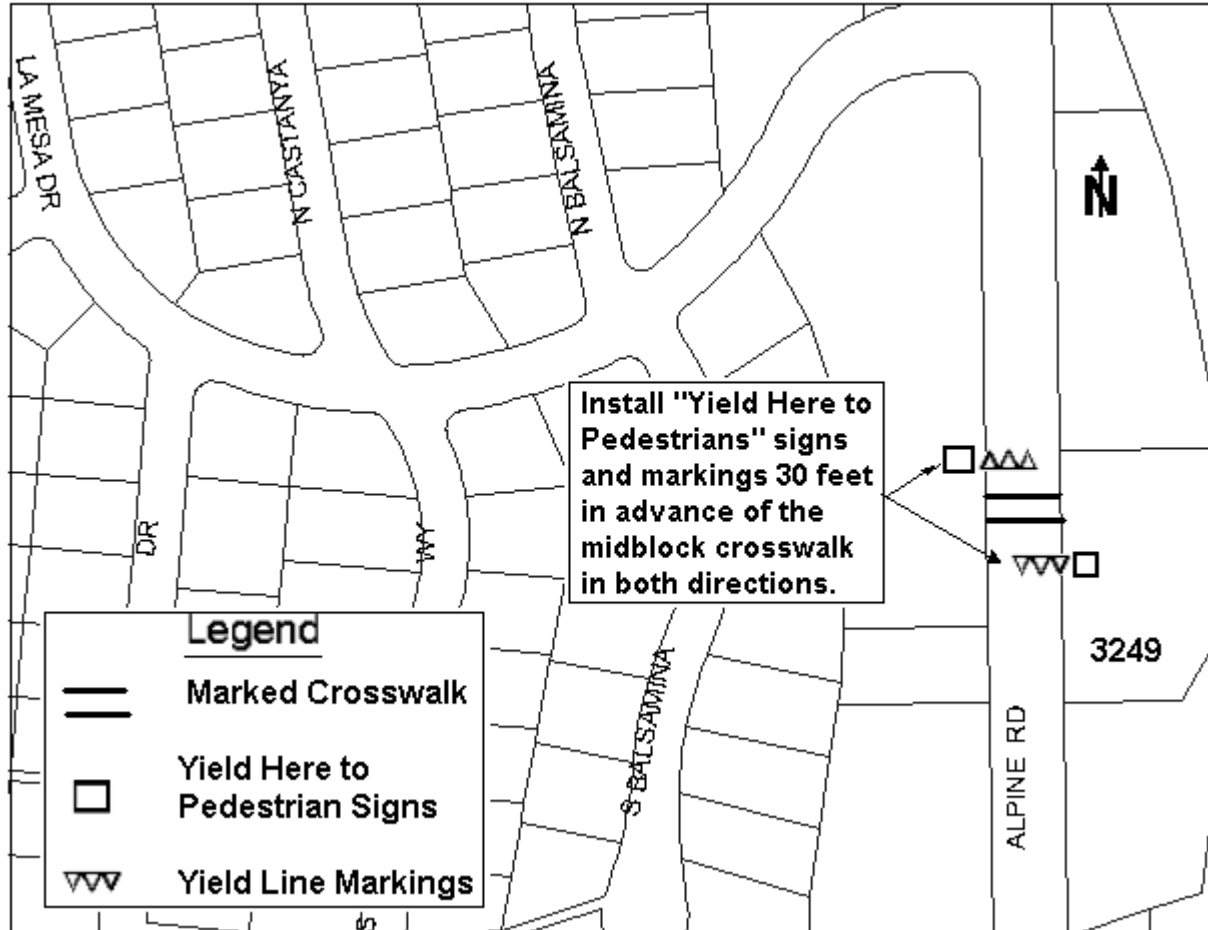
