Figure 1. Proposed Traffic Control Device Change in Location – Audubon Avenue

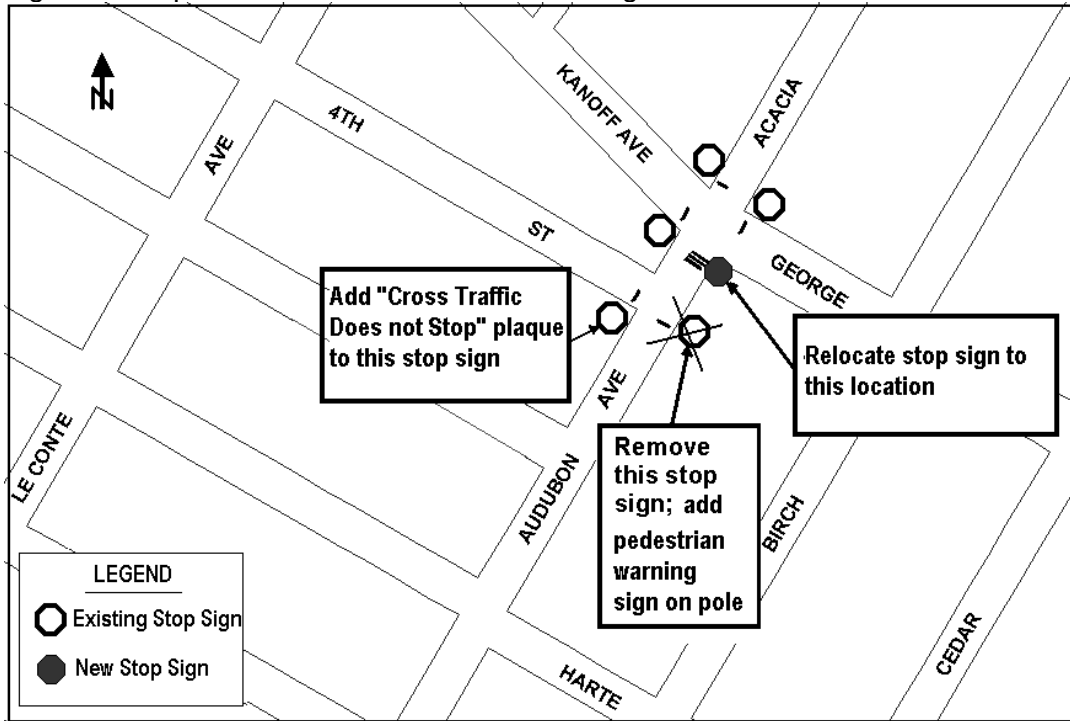
