**SUBJECT:** Continuation of Contracts

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Controller to continue payments on Health System contracts from July 1, 2011 through September 30, 2011.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Health System has a number of contracts for services that will expire on or before June 30, 2011 and are pending completion. These contracts, listed in the Resolution, will be submitted as new agreements or for extension by the end of September 2011.

#### DISCUSSION:

To ensure continued provision of services during the interim, it is necessary to authorize the Controller to continue to make payments to these contractors at the existing rates through September 30, 2011. This Resolution allows contractors to provide necessary services in a timely fashion and will allow the Health System the time needed to complete negotiations. For all agreements subject to this continuing resolution for payment purposes, all the terms and conditions of each agreement shall remain in effect during the term of the continuing resolution.

The contracts included in the Resolution are largely for services provided by the Behavioral Health and Recovery Services Division. Reduction of other federal and State funding sources resulted in delays in contract negotiations with community-based providers. We expect to bring most of the contracts to your Board in July.

The completion of contracts from Aging and Adult Services was delayed due to the late notice from the State regarding available funding for Area Agency on Aging services. We expect those contracts to be presented to your Board as a package by September.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the Resolution as to form.

Approval of this Resolution contributes to the Shared Vision 2025 outcome of a Healthy

Community by enabling the Health System to continue to provide a continuity of services to the community until final negotiations can be completed.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Funds for the annual costs of these contracts have been included in the Health System FY 2011-12 Recommended Budget.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONTROLLER TO CONTINUE PAYMENTS ON HEALTH SYSTEM CONTRACTS FROM JULY 1, 2011 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2011

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Agreements listed in Attachment A, incorporated by reference herein, expire on or before June 30, 2011, and new agreements have not been completed; and

WHEREAS, the Controller does not have the authority to make payments to these contractors between the expiration date and time of completion of the Agreements; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to continue payments to contractors listed in Attachment A through September 30, 2011 pending execution of new Agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that this Board of Supervisors authorizes the Controller to continue payments through September 30, 2011, on said Agreements for and on behalf of the County, subject to the contractors' continued compliance with all terms and conditions of the most recent agreements with the County with the exception of the maximum payment term

provision. Said payments are to be in the amounts authorized by the Chief of the Health System or designee at the existing rates in the most recent agreements with the County.
