**RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve the re-appointment of Bonnie Miller to the Juvenile Justice & Delinquency Prevention Youth Commission. Ms. Miller is a second term commissioner whose current term will expire on December 31, 2011. Ms. Miller's new term will expire on December 31, 2015.

**BACKGROUND:**

For the efficient and effective statutory compliance of the review of juvenile operations in this county, the Court and the Board have agreed that the appointee by the Court to the Juvenile Justice Commission is appointed concurrently by the Board of Supervisors to the Juvenile Justice & Delinquency Prevention Commission.

**DISCUSSION:**

With the recommendation of Juvenile Judge Susan Irene Etezadi, Presiding Judge Beth Labson Freeman has re-appointed: Bonnie Miller to the Juvenile Justice & Delinquency Prevention Youth Commission for the term prescribed by law. Her term new will expire on December 31, 2015. This is a request that the Board of Supervisors re-appoint the above-listed commissioner to the Juvenile Justice & Delinquency Prevention Youth Commission.
