The State of California will, within certain limits and depending on claim eligibility, reimburse victims and/or their dependents for medical/therapy expenses, loss of wages, funeral/burial expenses and/or other expenses resulting from a criminal act.

Unfortunately, the program cannot pay for lost, damaged, or stolen property.

Crimes may include, but are not limited to:

- **Domestic Violence**
- **Sexual Assault**
- **Child Abuse**
- **Assault**
- **Homicide**
- **Vehicular Manslaughter**
- **Elder Abuse**
- **Robbery**
- **Driving Under the Influence**
- **Criminal Threats**

Victims may suffer either physical injury and/or emotional harm as a result of a crime. The safety and emotional well being of victims and their families are a priority.

We have a network of responders within the County who are available to assist victims and their families.

Advocates are available to provide emergency assistance, resource and referral assistance, information and updates on court cases.
